## Foz do Iguassu/ Rio de Janeiro

Brazilian Breakfast Buffet at the hotel. Brazilian side of the falls

From the Iguassu National Park main gate to the top of the trail leading to the falls - a 25km drive through pristine Atlantic Forest lush vegetation. The trail going down the Iguassu river canyon is pleasant as it opens, here and there, to the spectacle of more than 240 falls that form the horseshoe-shaped Iguassu Falls. Reaching the bottom, a lookout takes you to the edge with waters circling around. A glass elevator moves you slowly up the cliff face for an exquisite view at the upper deck. The water volume is staggering and when the waters are high - sheer emotion! Brazil shares Iguassu Falls with Argentina and on both sides a National park protects the rainforest that surrounds this marvel! UNESCO has declared Iguassu Falls and both parks a National Heritage Site of Brazil and Argentina!

## Arrival Rio

Our uniformed, bi-lingual guides will meet the participants of the group, right after customs clearance. Transfer on deluxe air-conditioned motor coaches, takes approximately 35 minutes, depending on traffic conditions. En route, our guides welcome all participants on behalf of "the sponsor of the group" and brief passengers about Rio de Janeiro and their hotel. Arrival in Rio and transfer to hotel



Upon arrival at hotel, check in will take place at a separate area and while check in formalities take place, a Welcome Cocktail will be served and the room keys are handed out. Visit and Cocktail at Sugar Loaf

No setting could be more spectacular. The Sugar Loaf is composed of 2 hills. On arrival the guests will ascend to the top of Sugar Loaf by the cable car. After they have enjoyed the view, they descend to Morro da Urca, where a special area has been reserved for the cocktail party. The next hour is reserved for the guest to stroll at leisure, glass in hand, socializing, and enjoying the magnificent view of the city.

Dinner at Fogo de Chão restaurant

Fogo de Chão is how the gaucho cowboys prepare their meal, digging a pit on the ground, lighting a wood fire, skewring the beef and placing it to slowly barbecue while cooking the carreteiro rice and boiling the water for the chimarrão. While waiting for the meat to barbecue, they would sit around the pit piping hot herb tea - "mate" (chimarrão). Fogo de Chão today brings to mind a chain of successful restaurants, 8 in Brazil and 17 in the United States, serving a selection of prime cuts of beef: shoulder and ancho among others that are a delight to meat connoisseurs. The additional attraction of this restaurant is a superb bay and Sugar Loaf view from its salon and veranda, a treat by itself!
