**ORIENTATION WALKING TOUR OF FLORENCE - duration approx 3 hours**

The guide will then take guests through the fashionable Fiorentine streets to Florence's very heart and most important square the splendid Piazza della Signoria, the ancient political centre of the town to admire the Palazzo Vecchio. The tour will continue onto the ancient market place and then to the Ponte Vecchio, the oldest and most famous of the city's bridges, re-known for its shops and artisan laboratories.
