Upon arriving in the hotel, we welcome the group in the lobby of the Marriot hotel with Armenian brandy or wine. In their room the guests will find a program of their visit in Armenia, a fruit basket, and a bottle of Armenian wine.

Our guests will stay at the Marriott Hotel 5*, located on Republic Square. The Hotel offers the following facilities:

City tour

Our professional guides will be waiting in the lobby to accompany the guests in a comfortable coach.

The City Tour will begin with the familiarization of Yerevan - the capital of Armenia starting from the History Museum of Armenia. After the visit guests can have a short coffee break with delicious desserts in previously chosen cafes. Next is a visit the Genocide Memorial Complex and Museum of the victims of the Armenian Genocide in 1915.

After guests will have lunch at the one of the famous Armenian restaurants (previously chosen upon request) with traditional Armenian food . Our guests will be proposed to taste the best of traditional Armenian dishes and drinks.

After lunch we'll take a tour of the Matenadaran– one of the oldest and richest book depositories in the world. Its collection of about 17,000 manuscripts includes almost all the areas of ancient and medieval Armenian culture and sciences - history, medicine, philosophy, law, mathematic, calendar theory, alchemy-chemistry, translations, literature, chronology, art history, miniature, music, and theatre.



In the afternoon we'll visit Ararat Brandy Factory and Museum where our guest will explore the 120-year history of one of the world's most famous brandy factories. While visiting the factory guests can taste traditional Armenian cognac.

In the evening guests will have a dinner in one of the traditional Armenian restaurants (choice of restaurants depends of upon prior arrangement). Traditional folk dance and the mystical sounds of the ancient Armenian "duduk" one of the oldest double reed instruments in the world will be introduced to our guests during the evening. Of all the traditional Armenians instruments only the duduk is said to have really Armenian origin.
