Visa Information

Visa on Arrival (eligible Nationalities)

The Directorate of Residency and Foreigners Affairs in Dubai, have introduced a visa on arrival facility for 47 nationalities. Citizens of the following countries will have a 30 day visit visa stamped on their passports at the port of entry, eliminating the need to apply for a visa prior to arriving in the UAE. These can be extended for another 30 days by paying AED 620.

*Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, **Canada**, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Great Britain, Greece, Hong Kong SAR, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, San Marino, Singapore, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, USA, Vatican City, Poland, Slovenia, Slovakia, Czech Republic, Lithuania, Hungary, Latvia, Estonia, Malta, Cyprus, Croatia, Romania and Bulgaria.*

GCC Countries

Residents of the Gulf Cooperation Council should confirm with the UAE Consulate or Embassy in country of residence before traveling to the UAE.

VISA REQUIRED

All Nationalities which are not included in the countries above are not eligible for visa on arrival, and must apply for a visa through the UAE immigration authorities –we can do this on your guest's behalf.

List of Documents required to process Visas for guests:

1. Clear and valid passport copy of each guest (minimum validity of 6 months prior to arrival).
2. Colored (white background) passport size photo for each applicant.
3. Completed and signed Entry Visa Request Form for each guest.

Abu Dhabi Sheikh Zayed Mosque

Day 3

The Mosque was initiated by the late President of the UAE, HH Sheikh Zayed Bin Sultan Al Nahyan, who is fondly thought of as the father of the UAE. The design has been inspired by both the Mughal and the Moorish Mosque Architecture in Pakistan and Morocco.

There are four minarets on the four corners of the courtyard. The courtyard, with its floral design, measures about 17,000 m² considered to be the largest example of marble mosaic in the world. The Carpet in the main prayer hall has been designed by an Iranian artist, measuring 5627 m², weighing 35 tons using wool from New Zealand and Iran. The Chandeliers that are made in Germany incorporate millions of Swarovski Crystals.

Reflective pools surround the mosque, amplifying its beauty. The striking white and gold colors shining in the sun are transformed at night by a unique lightning system which reflects the phases of the moon.

Ramadan opening hours: During the Holy Month the mosque is open daily, except Friday, from 9am to 2pm, with last entry at 1.30pm.

Opening hours: Unlike other mosques in Abu Dhabi, the Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque is open daily to visitors, except on Friday morning, which is for worshippers only. The opening hours are 9am to 10pm (last entry at 9.30 pm) – Saturday to Thursday and 4.30pm to 10pm on Fridays. Complimentary one hour guided tours run (Sun-Thurs) at 10am, 11am and 5pm. Friday times are 5pm and 7pm and Saturday 10am, 11am, 2pm, 5pm and 7pm.

General Information about Dubai

Time Zone: Dubai is GMT +4

Language: The national language of the UAE is Arabic, although English is very widely spoken and understood

Temperature: The temperature in May – September ranges from low 30s - high 40s, between October- April it ranges from low 20s – low 30s, We recommend you use a strong sun block and wear a hat when you are out. Don't forget to bring your sunglasses.

Money: The unit of currency in the UAE is the Dirham 1 Dirham = 100 Fils – the rate of exchange against the USD is fixed – 1 USD = 3.65 AED. Shops accept all major credit cards, with VISA being the most welcome sign. The airport has many ATMs and exchange outlets

Clothing: We suggest you wear lightweight casual clothing for the daytime. Shorts can be worn, though we would ask you not to wear the very short variety. Ladies can wear sleeveless tops, though we would recommend you cover the tops of your arms when out in public places. Similarly, we would ask you not to wear anything that could be perceived as too revealing and may cause offence. In mosques, please wear long trousers and tops with long sleeves. Women to cover their hair (a pashmina or scarf is a good option here)

Entry Visas: Visas are required for all people visiting the UAE. Most European nationality passport holders can get this upon arrival in UAE, If participants hold other passports then we can apply in advance for visas.

Electricity: Electricity in the UAE is 220/240 volts AC, 50 Hz. UK-style 3 pin plugs are widespread throughout all the hotels.

Photography: Normal tourist photography is allowed but it is considered offensive to photograph Muslim women. It is also courteous to request permission before photographing the local men
