Everyone will need to meet your tour guide in the hotel foyer no later than 08:30am, where they will transfer you to your morning visit to the Yanjing Beer Company in Shunyi Industry area.

After you visit you will then be transferred back to downtown to a traditional Chinese family home to learn to make dumplings and enjoy the dumplings lunch.

Afternoon visit to Hutongs by rickshaw, having tea with a local family and have a nice walk around the Shichahai (In the Hutong, you will take part in an orientation game: in small groups you will have to find different spots and collect information and complete different tasks) – similar to the 'Amazing race'.

The Hutongs are ancient city alleys or lanes. In these back lanes lined with authentic courtyard houses, is where the ordinary people lived during the Yuan (1206-1341), Ming (1368-1628), and Qing (1644-1911) Dynasties. In the prime of these dynasties, the emperors, in order to establish their absolute power, planned the city and arranged the residential areas. Currently about half the population of Beijing lives in Hutongs, which comprises one-third of the city's total area

Then you will transfer to Wangfujing Night Market to explore the local cuisine. – it is very interesting and worth to do it.
