SIM: Samsung Innovation Museum exhibits the history and the future of innovations brought by the electronics industry.

- The SkyArt gallery on the 60th floor. The gallery opened in 2008 and was named the "highest art gallery in the world." Aside from displaying a variety of masterpieces, visitors can also come here to enjoy the beautiful scenery as well.

- The 63 Wax Museum is a favorite amongst visitors to 63 City. Guests can tour the Museum and take photos with wax figures of historical personages. As many as 70 wax figures made by a renowned Japanese artist are 1.5 times larger than actual size to provide greater detailed and appear life-like in photos.

Club Ellui

Don't be fooled by the modest entrance, this is a massive multi-level club. Inside, there are three main sections where music is played. The VIP white room plays lounge style house music, the DJ's in the black room spin funky to hard electro full of bass, and the main stage is where resident and world famous DJ's perform. It's probably the club with the most room to dance and it won't feel too busy, so if you like to roam around, there's enough going on to keep you entertained.
